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Medications to be Avoided Before Surgery

Many medications and food compounds that are taken for generalised wellbeing, pain relief, or to ensure the blood stays thin for problems with heart, brain and limb blood supply are not recommended before elective surgery.

These medications may cause serious and potentially life-threatening peri and postoperative bleeding and should be avoided ten days before surgery and not be recommenced for at least two to three weeks after surgery.

Obviously, any decision to cease any of these medications should be discussed with your GP or cardiologist to ensure it is safe to do so.

Should there be any confusion regarding these instructions, please do not hesitate to discuss these with Dr Farrell.

The list below contains many of the common medications and food compounds that should be avoided. It is by no means exhaustive.

Natural therapy or vitamin supplements that should be avoided. These include all natural therapy preparations, particularly those containing fish oil, omega 3 supplements, glucosamine and multivitamins. Food additives can also cause bleeding and should be avoided.
